
Getting to UQCCR



From Brisbane Domestic Airport the best way is via taxi or rideshare.

Via the Airport Link M7 Tunnel (tolls will be added to your fare), it will take about 15 min to get to the Butterfield St entrance of the Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital (RBWH). From there, enter the main doors of the hospital and walk straight ahead and up the escalator. Keeping walking straight ahead and out the doors into the seating area for the cafeteria. Go straight ahead and up the ramp or stairs, and across Central Drive and onto Main Drive, past the RBWH Education Centre and Pulse Café. UQCCR is right next to Pulse Café (see map below).

If you don't like tunnels or tolls, it will take about 20 min from the airport to the RBWH. Ask the driver if you will be going down O'Connell Tce – if so, tell them to go straight ahead into the hospital grounds (on Central Drive) when they get to Bowen Bridge Rd, and then ask them to stop just after the first pedestrian crossing. UQCCR is then just a short walk away on the left (see map below).

By public transport

Buses travelling on the Inner Northern Busway route (e.g. routes 66, 330, 333, 360 and others) all stop at the RBWH bus station, which is approximately 100 m walk from UQCCR (see map below). If you are coming by train, it is easiest to get off at Roma St station, and catch one of the above buses to RBWH.

By car

Parking is available at parking stations on the corner of Herston Rd and Bowen Bridge Rd or on Butterfield St (~ \$35/day). Metered street parking is often available just in front of the UQ Medical School on Herston Rd (approx. 10 min walk to UQCCR).
